Horsemastership Program General Information

CSHA members in good standing may participate in the Horsemastership program. They must compete in the Region in which they reside.

There are five categories:

English I (jumping), **English II** (flat work only), **Gymkhana** (barrels & poles), **Western** (stock seat), **Combined** (jumping and stock seat).

Within each category there are two divisions: **Junior** and **Adult**

Juniors: less than 18 years of age (see CSHA rule book)

Adults: 18 years or older; there is no upper age limit

The competition involves three tests: Riding, Written, and Grooming

Region and State programs are conducted per the current CSHA rule book, Horsemastership section.

Region Chairman responsibilities:

- Attend region meetings
- Attend CSHA meetings (January, April, July, November) **The chairman is a voting member and integral part of the CSHA State Horsemastership committee.**
- Promote the program
- Set dates & times for Region tests
- Hire qualified judges
- Attend Show of Champions (CSHA State competition)
- Fundraising to cover Region costs
- Assist with fundraising for CSHA State Horsemastership program
