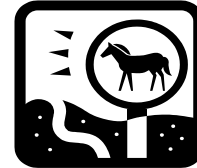
Old Business:

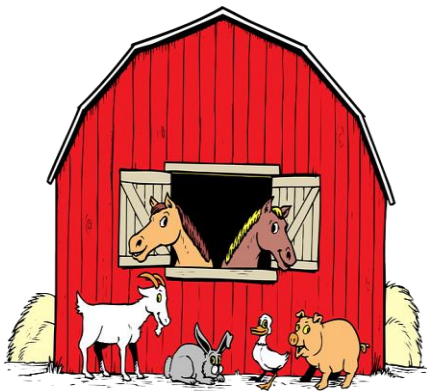
