+ West Nile Virus in our area- Char Schramm- Three confirmed cases in Riverside Co. this year. Our County is the worst in the state. Keep your horses vaccinated. Do not forget every six months. This is very important.

+ Char Schramm – As per Ranger Robert, at the end of Etiwanda barriers that block entrance into the riverbed may not come down until October or November due to the resources/ crews' priorities at other locations, including Rancho Jurupa Valley.

+A step over is planned at the end of Etiwanda to help curb motorized traffic.
