GYMKHANA, SEC. 3.0 Region Chairman's Responsibilities, rule 3.4.1, new rule

If the form is not submitted by the deadline the show's sanction will not be valid.

**RESOLUTION #G 2** 

GYMKHANA, SEC. 8.0 Types of Divisions, rule 8.4 Average Time Division, sub rules 8.4.7.2 and 8.4.7.3 and 8.4.7.3.1

**WHEREAS**, the dates in these rules often fall on the Labor Day week-end when a number of shows are held, and;

**WHEREAS**, deleting a combination from the Rating List Saturday night means they have to ride in Open on Sunday which causes a lot of confusion and frustration, and;

**WHEREAS**, a number of the deleted combination's attain their Current Year Rating by September 15<sup>th</sup> (end of the point year) and have to be added back onto the list causing more confusion and work;

Therefore, Be It *Resolved* that GYMKHANA, SEC. 8.0 Types of Divisions, rule 8.4 Average Time Division, sub rules 8.4.7.2 and 8.4.7.3 be amended as follows, and 8.4.7.3.1 be deleted.

- **8.4.7.2** The YER shall be valid through September 20th of the following year.
- **8.4.7.3** On September 21st, every combination that has not received a Current Year's Rating (CYR) shall be dropped from the Rating List.

**8.4.7.3.1** After September 1<sub>st</sub>, and on or before September 15th if a combination that was dropped from the Rating List receives a CYR the combination will not be placed in a division that is lower than their YER.

#### **RESOLUTION #G3**

GYMKHANA, SEC. 15.0 State Championship Show (SCS), sub section 15.3 Eligibility, rule 15.3.2 Rated Divisions, sub rule 15.3.2.4

WHEREAS, the State Championship Show does not limit the number of entries it accepts from each Region, and;

WHEREAS, it would benefit the SCS to have more riders, and;

WHEREAS, removing the requirement for Regions to sanction other Regions gymkhanas to count for SCS would reduce the work by Region Gymkhana Chairs to sanction a show and;

WHEREAS, allowing riders to count all CSHA Gymkhana Sanctioned Point Shows to count for SCS would give riders more opportunity to get qualified to go to SCS;

Therefore, Be It *Resolved* that GYMKHANA, SEC. 15.0 State Championship Show (SCS), subsection 15.3 Eligibility, rule 15.3.2 Rated Divisions, subrule 15.3.2.4 be amended as follows:

Change "of their Region's Sanctioned Point Shows" to "CSHA Gymkhana Sanctioned Point Shows"

### Change:

"After December 31st and on or before September 15th of the following year, the combination must compete in all rating events in a minimum of five (5) of their Region's Sanctioned Point Shows. Shows ridden prior to Region Registration may NOT be used to meet the five (5) show requirement."

### Revised:

After December 31st and on or before September 15th of the following year, the combination must compete in all rating events in a minimum of five (5) CSHA Gymkhana Sanctioned Point Shows. Shows ridden prior to Region Registration may NOT be used to meet the five (5) show requirement.

## **RESOLUTION # G 4**

GYMKHANA, SEC. 17.0 Assisted Rider Division, rule 17.2 State Championship Show, sub rule 17.2.5 and 17.2.7.1

WHEREAS, because of this the precedent has been that all awards were donated and no funds from the regular SCS funds could be used to purchase awards for this event, and;

WHEREAS, this needs to be added into the rules so there is no misunderstanding of the resources available:

Therefore, be it *Resolved* that Gymkhana, SEC. 17.0 Assisted Rider Division, rule 17.2 State Championship Show, sub rule 17.2.5 and 17.2.7.1 amended as follows:

### Add to 17.2.5

Funds for awards must be donated and handled by the event manager.

Funds may not be deposited into or checks be written out of the State Championship Show's account to cover expenses

Delete 17.2.7.1 in its entirety and replace with:

Awards are at the discretion of the event manager. Awards must be donated. Awards must be ordered and/or purchased by the event manager.
