WHEREAS, AERC now has distances not reflected in our points systems we recommend the points system be changed to:

Therefore Be It *Resolved* that Endurance, SEC. 2.0 High Point Program, rule 2.1 be amended as follows:

25-49 miles

1 point per mile
1 point per horse
passed

50-74 miles

Endurance, SEC. 2.0 High Point Program, rule 2.2

WHEREAS, we have been recognizing Overall Best Condition since 2010 and Overall High Point Endurance Rider in honor of past State Endurance Chairman Richard Theodore (who passed away in 2010), and;

WHEREAS, AERC now includes a featherweight division and weights of other divisions have changed since last rules update;

Therefore Be It *Resolved* that Endurance, SEC. 2.0 High Point Program, rule 2.2 be amended as follows:

Points will be earned after the receipt of application and fee. There will be awards for 1st to 5th places in five divisions: Featherweight (160 lbs. or lighter), Lightweight (161-185 lbs.), Middleweight (186-210 lbs.), Heavyweight (211 lbs. and over), and Junior riders.

There will also be an overall Best Condition award, and an overall High Point Rider Endurance award that includes all divisions.

Resolution E 3
Endurance, SEC. 4.0 Rules for a CSHA Sanctioned Ride

WHEREAS, the language of the current rule is not clear about what is a CSHA sanctioned ride, and;

WHEREAS, current practice (for the past 16 years) is to count all AERC sanctioned rides toward CSHA State Endurance points;

Therefore Be It *Resolved* that Endurance, SEC. 4.0 Rules for a CSHA Sanctioned Ride be amended as follows:

To be a CSHA sanctioned ride, the event must conform to the rules of the American Endurance Ride Conference (AERC). All American Endurance Ride Conference (AERC) sanctioned distances 25-100 miles count toward CSHA State Endurance points.
