WHEREAS, the program framework will be changed to reflect a system to promote Region royalty with the ability to continue on to the state level competition,

Therefore Be It *Resolved* that Royalty, Sec.1.0 General Rules be amended as follows:

1.1 Royalty is a State **and Region** Program

The sections regarding the coordinator positions be changed as follow; deleting current wording and substitute wording to designate Region Chairmen

~~3.1.2 Appoint Region Coordinators when needed. Appointment must be approved by the Region's President~~

3.1.2 Assist the Region Chairmen on all aspects of the program to promote a Region competition and encourage participation at the State level.

3.1.2.1 Regions that may not have active programs but have interested participants may select a Coordinator, as approved by the Region's president; they will work directly with the State Chair.

~~3.1.2.1 Region Coordinators will function as supporters of the program and its participants~~

~~3.1.2.2 Coordinators will report directly to the State Chair~~

WHEREAS, our Royalty youth are a great Public Relations aspect of CSHA, there should be encouragement that they participate in our major events as their commitment to the position, and;

WHEREAS, their public appearances and participation is a reflection on their person and their CSHA Royalty reign and they should be encouraged to make those commitments, and;

WHEREAS, there are times that our youth also have rigid school commitments that do not allow for some outside commitments, and;

WHEREAS, while we strongly encourage our youth to meet all event requirements we must recognize that conflicts and situations do arise that must be accommodated;

Therefore Be It *Resolved* that Royalty, Sec. 4.0 Reign, rule 4.3 be amended as follows:

4.3 The presence of youth at our functions is vital to building a strong future for CSHA. The following events are ~~now~~ **recognized as the events the royals should plan to attend. mandatory unless prior 30-day notice is given to the State Royalty Chair. The only exception to this rule would be in the event of an emergency in which case the State Royalty chair must be notified. Commitments to scheduled events is expected; notify the State Chair of scheduling conflicts as soon as possible. Missing events for which a royal has committed to attend will be in case of emergency/ illness only; notify the State Chair immediately.**
