+ Sondra Harkless gave ETP a heartfelt thanks for her membership!

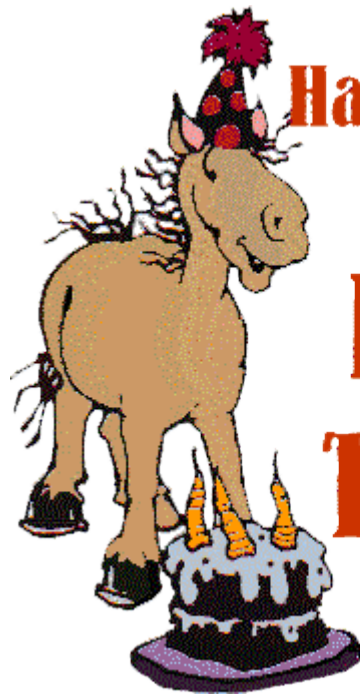
