GET YOUR TRAIL REPORTS TO JENNIFER!

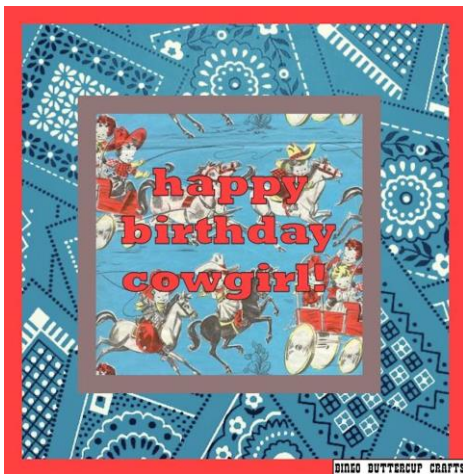
